

When you tell a staff member about a Safeguarding Concern, what happens next?



They will talk to a member of the safeguarding team
(Miss Balderstone, Jez Mark, Leeann Bell, Megan Bland, Mrs Rose or Sharon Harris)
and they will record what you have said



Depending on what you have told us the team will look at what
action needs to happen—this could be:

- * Speak to you parent/carer
- * Speak to other students
- * One to one support in school
- * Referral to a service to support you (might be in or out of school)



If we need more help to help you we might:

- * Arrange a meeting with parents (+ you) and others who could support
- * Refer to the Early Help panel
- * Call and/or refer to the safeguarding hub

We are here to support you. We will tell you what is happening. We will try our best to be discreet. The person that you told will be involved as that is who you felt comfortable to tell.
