Need support looking for work or need benefit advice?

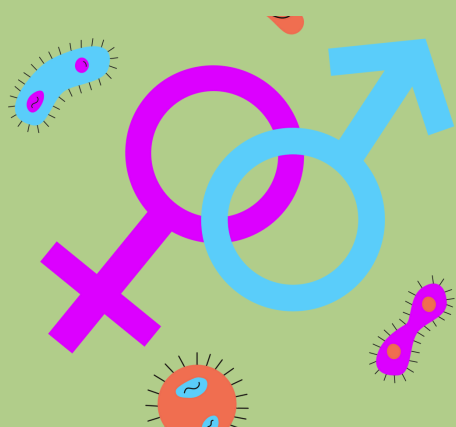

Inspira

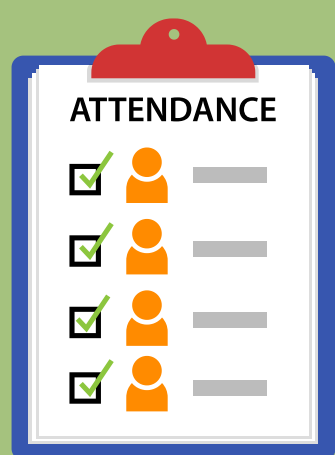
Do you need information about your year 11 child and what options there are when they leave school? If so, Olivia, our Inspira advisor, is here to help.

School Nurse and Sexual Health

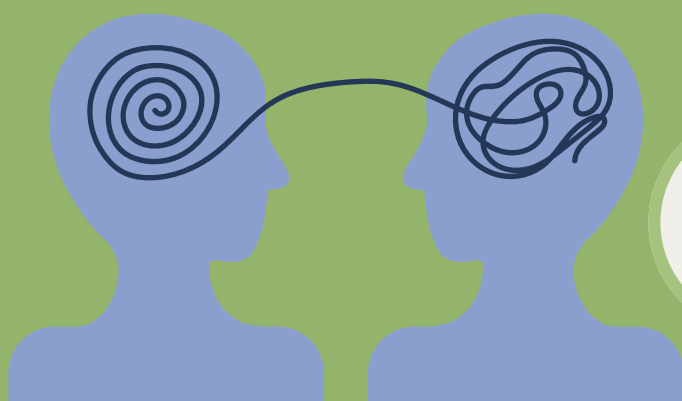
